

# Verbo To be: Negative Form

En la clase anterior presentamos el verbo TO BE (ser /estar) en su forma afirmativa, en ésta aprenderemos la forma negativa.

## Verb TO BE Negative

Long Form	Short Form
I <b>am not</b>	I'm <b>not</b>
You <b>are not</b>	You <b>aren't</b>
He <b>is not</b>	He <b>isn't</b>
She <b>is not</b>	She <b>isn't</b>
It <b>is not</b>	It <b>isn't</b>
We <b>are not</b>	We <b>aren't</b>
You <b>are not</b>	You <b>aren't</b>
They <b>are not</b>	They <b>aren't</b>

Para formar el negativo se agrega NOT al verbo (am, is, are). Al igual que en el afirmativo, el negativo también tiene dos formas: larga y corta.

### **Ejemplos:**

I **am** a doctor. (Yo soy un doctor). → Oración afirmativa.

I **am not** a doctor: ( Yo no soy un doctor). → Oración negativa).

He **is** Mexican. (Él es Mexicano). → Oración afirmativa.

He **is not** Mexican. (Él no es Mexicano). → Oración negativa.

It **is** a ruler. (esto es una regla). → Oración afirmativa.

It **is not** a ruler. (Esto no es una regla). → Oración negativa.

We **are** at school. (Nosotros estamos en la escuela). → Oración afirmativa.

We **are not** at school. (Nosotros no estamos en la escuela). → Oración negativa.
